

## **Recommended Adult\* Equine Preventative Vaccination Program** (1/16)

VACCINE	ADMINISTERED IM - Intramuscular IN - Intranasal	FREQUENCY
Tetanus/Sleeping Sickness <sup>1</sup>	IM	Annually <sup>4</sup>
Tetanus/Sleeping Sickness/West Nile Virus Combination	IM	Annually <sup>3 &amp; 4</sup>
Rabies	IM	Annually <sup>4</sup>
Flu/Rhino or Flu	IM or IN	Every 6 months
Strangles (IN) <sup>2</sup>	IN	Annually <sup>4</sup>
West Nile	IM	Annually <sup>4 &amp; 5</sup>

(\*Horses 1 year of Age or Older)

- <sup>1</sup> In case of a penetrating wound, Tetanus Toxoid should be given if greater than 6 months since vaccination. If no prior Tetanus Toxoid can be verified, consider using Tetanus Antitoxin.
- <sup>2</sup> We recommend the use of this vaccine only where there is known or possible exposure.
- <sup>3</sup> If this vaccine is given in late March to a previously vaccinated horse, a West Nile booster in the same year should not be necessary
- <sup>4</sup> Previously unvaccinated adults should be boostered 3-4 weeks after their initial vaccine.

<sup>5</sup> This vaccine should be given in March or April (once yearly) if the Tetanus/Sleeping Sickness/West Nile combination is <u>not</u> used.
