

EQUINE HEALTHCARE PROGRAM

Loomis Basin Equine Medical Center, Inc. is offering an Equine Healthcare Program. Annual examinations, routine dental care, vaccinations and deworming help to improve the health of your horse.

What are the benefits to this Program?

- No emergency fees for emergencies seen at the clinic (\$80-\$100 savings per visit)
- \$3,000 credit towards surgical treatment of colic performed at Loomis Basin Equine Medical Center
- Additional discounts on specified medication purchases (i.e. Adequan, Gastrogard, Legend)
- Additional discounts on specific elective surgeries

What are the requirements for enrollment?

One scheduled veterinary appointment per year to include:

1. Routine physical exam - \$72
2. Routine teeth float (*exceptions for younger horses*) - \$220
3. Annual required vaccinations (*possible exceptions*):
 - a. 3-Way w/ West Nile - \$42
 - b. Rabies - \$20
4. Deworming: Four times per year – as little as \$6 each (depending on type of paste)
**Meeting the deworming criteria for Pfizer's Preventicare is also acceptable

**Above prices are for the 2010 enrollment year*

We can include vaccines, exams and dentals that were done during the past 12 months. The coverage offered through this program is in addition to the benefits provided by Preventicare.
